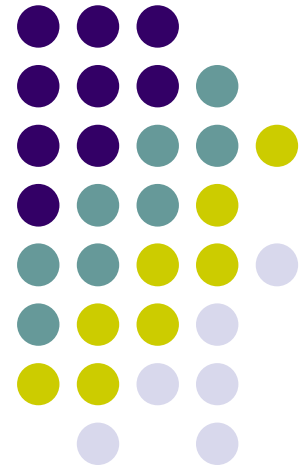
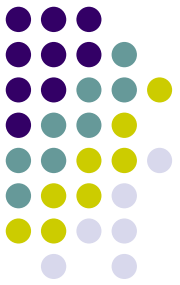

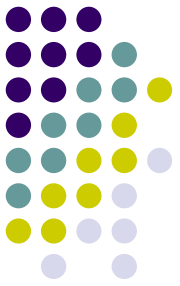

- Sign, ratify and implement CoE Convention on Cybercrime
- Adopt and implement legislation on personal data protection including protection of privacy on the Internet harmonised with the relevant EU framework

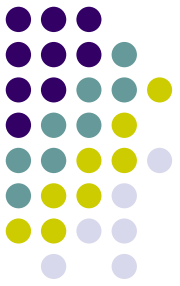

Comments:

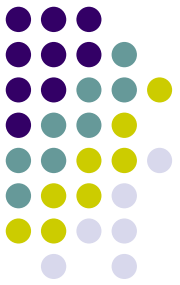
- Moldova signed, but not ratified the Convention. Law on Cybercrime is being drafted.
- Law on Personal Data Protection was adopted by the Government in January 2008. It is currently in the Parliamentary procedure.

eSEE Agenda + (2007-2012)



- High speed broadband networks and secure services
 - Establish national CERTs and exchange information (by end 2008)
- Full harmonization of rules for Information Society and Media (by end 2008)
- National and regional level Infrastructure for secure e-business
 - National Root CAs (by mid 2009)
- Follow European Safer Internet Plus practice (by 2012):
 - Fighting illegal content through public support
 - Raising safer Internet awareness among teachers, parents and children
 - Limiting unwanted and harmful content through content rating, filtering technology and fighting spam
 - Promoting a safer environment through Safer Internet Forum

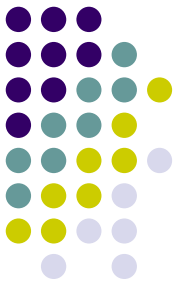

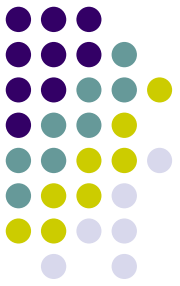
- Root CA – AL, BA, RS started the process of establishment. MK has two commercial CAs.

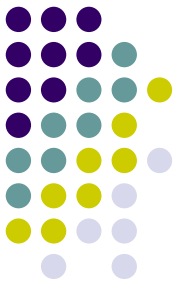

Croatia - Legal Framework

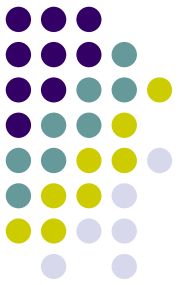
